RULES: All races will be sailed in accordance with current Racing Rules of Sailing and with Class rules where applicable. Sailing instructions will be provided at Registration. One race constitutes a regatta. Six or more races will be attempted. If six or more races are completed, there will be a throw-out race.

CLASSES: Three boats are required to form a class. Expected classes include: Sunfish, Laser, Laser Radial, 470, 420, V-15, Daysailers, Windsurfers, Catamarans and Portsmouth. One trophy will be awarded for 3-4 boats, 2 for 5-7, 3 for 8-9, 4 for 10-11, and 5 for 12 or more.

Registration is \$40 per boat, and \$20 for each additional crew/support/family member above a one person boat.

Late registration (after May 31st) will be an additional \$15, and will be available on site on the day.

Minors (under 18 years of age) accompanied by an adult other than a parent or guardian SHALL bring a completed REASSIGNMENT OF CONSENT form. No such minor will be allowed to enter and compete without this completed form.

PETS are not permitted on the Club grounds.

DIRECTIONS: Interstate 45 to Nasa Road One. East on Nasa Road One past Clear Lake. At Hwy 146, in Seabrook, Nasa Road One becomes Second Avenue. Follow Second Avenue less than one mile to its end, where it tees into Todville Rd. Right on Todville Road. SSC is 250 feet on the left.
