From Rebuild:

The exterior structure is finished with some plumbing and electrical finishing work needed. In the interior large room the walls are almost finished with most of the painting completed. the kitchen cabinets are installed with Countertops, sinks and Microwaves. The Bar should be finished next week. The tile floors are being installed this week and next. Appliances are scheduled for delivery late next week.

Bathrooms and Storage room walls and ceilings are being finished. The Concrete float is done. The tile floor in the women's is in. Grouting will be done next week.

The elevator Shaft is almost complete. The elevator equipment will take several weeks to install. (SSC will be able to use the club before the elevator is installed) Stairs railings are close to completion after a design change. The Mausoleum is

complete. The ADA ramp design may be changed and less expensive materials used. The Cost out of various material is being studied. Landscaping of the front area is finished the rest will be done last after the ramp is done.

The Concrete slab - is being used by clubmembers now.

SSC Clubhouse is getting close to being finished.

From the Treasurer:

The board believes that the club needs to raise dues by \$10 effective July 1st, 2010 and a further \$10 effective January 1st, 2011. This will put senior active membership at \$60/month at the beginning of 2011.

The members vote on this by-law amendment will be on July 4th at 4pm at the Seabrook Sailing club.
