From Grounds:

In recent weeks the Grounds Committee has worked on the following tasks:

Establishing the new grass located on the bay side of the building with fertilizer and daily watering

Removed the debris pile stacked by the dumpster

Leveled the front entrance to the club to improve mowing

Installed two (2) covers that will mark and protect survey markers in the boat rigging area

Removed two (2) trash cans filled with dirt that were installed as bollards at the boat rigging area

Disposed of most of the cinder blocks stacked by the Port Boat Ramp

Scanned the parking area with a magnet to remove nails

Installed pavers at the outdoor shower that replaces the wood base

On the "To do list"

Install a trash can rack at the rigging area

Install two (2) hose reels to properly store water hoses

Repair outdoor shower

Install two (2) pilings as bollards at the boat rigging area

The remaining stack of cinder blocks and pavers located beside the port boat ramp are available for members to take on a first come first serve basis.
